Day 1 Kuching City & Shopping Tour

Upon arrival at Kuching International Airport, our friendly representative will meet and accompany you for the tour of the day. Kuching City is well-preserved with its historical buildings and this is clearly reflected when you move around the city. It has been divided into North and South led by the 2 capable mayors. The 'Astana', General Post Office, City Tower, the Sarawak Museum are among the fine examples of colonial-style architectures. A visit to the prominent landmarks such as the famous Kuching Waterfront, Tua Pek Kong Temple, Main Bazaar, Carpenter Street and the Chinese Museum will sure bring your memories alive. The world's first Cat Museum, a must visit attraction offers variety of cat souvenirs, photos and exhibits. It will definitely makes you love more about Kuching. You can find a wide range of local souvenirs such as pepper sweets, pepper biscuits, pepper root and pepper perfume, exotic delicacy like bird-nests, Sarawak potteries, arts and crafts. Our tour ends for the day with a transfer to city hotel of your choice for check-in.

Day 2 Sarawak Cultural Village– Orang Utan– Sarawak Pottery Factory (B/L)

After breakfast, we drive down to the SARAWAK CULTURAL VILLAGE which is an award-winning living museum. It is situated on a 17-acre site at the foothill of the legendary Mount Santubong facing the South China Sea. It is a golden opportunity to see and to explore the diversity of multi-racial cultural, lifestyle, history, tradition and architecture. There are seven fascinating houses representing every major ethnic group in Sarawak such as the Bidayuh House (also known as Land Dayak), Iban House (also known as Sea Dayak), Orang Ulu Longhouse, a Penan Jungle Settlement, the Melanau Tall House, a Malay Town House and a Chinese Farm House. All the houses are staffed with members dressed in their own unique traditional costumes and our experience guide will describe and interpret their lifestyle as well as their traditional cultures. A 45-minute extraordinary theatrical cultural show will be held. The magnificent yet colorful costumes will make your visit to the Sarawak Cultural Village a memorable one. Lunch is served at local restaurant.



We drive down to the SEMENGGOH ORANG UTAN REHABILITATION CENTRE. The journey takes approximately 30 minutes drive from the Kuching city center. Here, we take a short hike through the dipterocarp forest. In this centre, young orang utans are trained to survive in the wild. These orang utans are either orphaned or rescued from captivity. When they have sufficient skills to survive in the wild, the orang utans are released into the forest. During the feeding

time, visitors can watch their skillful movement and to observe their behavior and characteristics. Spot their delicate nests and our experience tour guide will elaborates more of this special primate called "Man of the forest". Other animals that can be found in the sanctuary are the gibbons and honey bears.

En route visit to SARAWAK POTTERY FACTORY. Sarawak is well-known for its one of a kind designed potteries. It is among the famous souvenirs found in Kuching. The motif of the pottery is closely related to human, animals and plants. Examples of the motifs are tigers, hornbills, coconut trees, leaves and even shadow of a woman. Potteries are widely used as kitchen utensils, flower pot, lamps, vases and the list is endless. Here at the pottery factory, there is a wide array of potteries for you to choose. Our tour for the day ends with a transfer to the hotel for overnight stay.

Day 3 Departure from Kuching (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Free at leisure until check-out and transfer to Kuching International Airport for your departure flight.
