Day 1 Kuching City-Shopping Tour

Upon arrival at Kuching International Airport, our friendly representative will meet and accompany you to KUCHING CITY & SHOPPING TOUR. Kuching's city centre is well-preserved with its historical buildings and this is clearly reflected when you move around the city. Kuching has been divided into North and South led by the 2 capable mayors. The 'Astana', General Post Office, City Tower, The Sarawak Museum are among the fine examples of colonial-style architectures. A visit to the prominent landmarks such as the famous Kuching Waterfront, Tua Pek Kong Temple, Main Bazaar, Carpenter Street and the Chinese Museum will sure bring your memories alive. The world's first Cat Museum, a must visit attraction offers variety of cat souvenirs, photos and exhibits. It will definitely makes you love more about Kuching. Kuching also offers a wide range of local souvenirs such as pepper sweets, pepper biscuits, pepper root and pepper perfume, exotic delicacy like bird-nests, Sarawak potteries, arts and crafts which can be found in Kuching. After tour, transfer to city hotel of your choice for check-in.



Day 2 Sarawak Cultural Village – Sarawak River Sunset Cruise (B/L)

After breakfast, we drive down to the SARAWAK CULTURAL VILLAGE. A unique award-winning living museum is a "must see" attraction if you would like to experience Sarawak's diversified cultures in half a day. The Sarawak Cultural Village is situated on a 17-acre site at the foothill of the legendary Mount Santubong facing the South China Sea. The village offers a golden opportunity to see and to explore the diversity of multi-racial cultural, lifestyle, history, tradition and architecture. There are seven fascinating houses representing every major ethnic group in Sarawak such as the Bidayuh House (also known as Land Dayak), Iban House (also known as Sea Dayak), Orang Ulu Longhouse, a Penan Jungle Settlement, the Melanau Tall House, a Malay Town House and a Chinese Farm House. All the houses are staffed with members dressed in their own unique traditional costumes and our experience guide will describe and interpret their lifestyle as well as their traditional cultures. A 45-minute extraordinary cultural show will be performed at the in-house theatre. The magnificent yet colorful costumes will make your visit to the Sarawak Cultural Village a memorable one. Lunch is served at a local restaurant.

After lunch, we drive back to KUCHING city for souvenir shopping. A stop at Main Bazaar enables the visitors to shop for Borneo arts and crafts such as the famous Sarawak wood carving, mats, 'pua kumbu' etc. The other exotic delicacies yet excellent quality is the bird nests. Then we proceed to the bird nest processing factory where a video presentation is shown in a very spacious show room. Apart from bird nests, other souvenirs such as the pepper products (pepper sweets, pepper biscuits, pepper root and pepper perfume), key chains and T-shirts are sold in the factory with reasonable price. Another well-known souvenir is the pottery and it is definitely unique. You can watch or even try to do your own pottery in the factory.

Then we proceed with our SARAWAK RIVER CRUISE. The cruise departs from the famous Kuching Waterfront and along the way, visitors can see the Malay Village and it reflects so clearly about the new and the old faces of Kuching. Fort Margherita, the Astana, the Square Tower and the Mosque can easy be spotted when you sail along the Sarawak River. It is simply a breathtaking way to relax. To know more about the historical Kuching a "story teller" on board will brief you along the way. After cruise, transfer back to hotel for overnight stay.
