Day 2 Serikin-Kuching City & Shopping Tour-Satok Market (B/L/D)

After breakfast at the hotel, we drive down to *Serikin* where it is a shopping paradise located closely to the border of Kalimantan, Indonesia. The journey to Serikin is approximately 2 hours drive from Kuching city center passing through the town of Bau. There is no requirement for either visa or passport for visitors who visit Serikin as the exact shopping location is in Sarawak itself. A myriad of goods are found here with the most reasonable price offer to the visitors such as the clothing, local delicacies, toys, dolls, wood carving, mat and the list goes on. Here, you can also enjoy the warm hospitality given by the local villages and the shopping experience is simply amazing. Lunch is provided at local restaurant.

After lunch, we return to Kuching. Its city centre is well-preserved with historical buildings and this is clearly reflected when you move around the city. Kuching has been separated into North and South led by the 2 capable mayors. The Astana, General Post Office, City Tower, Sarawak Museum are among the fine examples of colonial-style architectures. A visit to the prominent landmarks such as the famous Kuching Waterfront, Tua Pek Kong Temple, Main Bazaar, Carpenter Street and the Chinese Museum will sure bring your memories alive. The world's first Cat Museum, a must visit attraction offers variety of cat souvenirs, photos and exhibits, it will definitely makes you love more about Kuching. Kuching also offers a wide range of local souvenirs such as the famous pepper products (pepper sweets, pepper biscuits, pepper root and pepper perfume) bird-nests, Sarawak potteries, arts and crafts.

In the evening, we browse around at the **SATOK WEEKEND MARKET** which is situated at Jalan Satok. Business starts on every Saturday afternoon until night and Sunday morning until noon time. The best time to go to the weekend market is either on Saturday night or early Sunday morning. The market offers lots of stuff like vegetables, handicrafts, pets, stationeries, plants, forest products, utensils, magazines, fruits and the list goes on. Prices are reasonable here. Local snack and delicacies can also be found here. While exploring the market, visitors can also experience the warm hospitality among the local people as well as to enjoy the street lifestyle, simply a must visit attraction. After dinner at local restaurant, the tour ends for the day with a transfer back to hotel for overnight stay.
