### Day 1 Kuching City & Shopping Tour

Upon arrival in the Kuching International Airport, our friendly representative will meet and accompany you to KUCHING CITY & SHOPPING TOUR. Kuching's city centre is well-preserved with its historical buildings and this is clearly reflected when you move around the city. Kuching has been separated into North and South led by the 2 capable mayors. The Astana, General Post Office, City Tower, Sarawak Museum are among the fine examples of colonial-style architectures. A visit to the prominent landmarks such as the famous Kuching Waterfront, Tua Pek Kong Temple, Main Bazaar, Carpenter Street and the Chinese Museum will sure bring your memories alive. The world's first Cat Museum, a must visit attraction offers variety of cat souvenirs, photos and exhibits, it will definitely makes you love more about Kuching. Kuching also offers a wide range of local souvenirs such as the famous pepper products (pepper sweets, pepper biscuits, pepper root and pepper perfume ) bird-nest, arts and crafts which can be found in Kuching. After tour, transfer to city hotel of your choice for check-in & overnight.



### Day 2 Borneo Highland Resort Day Trip (B/L)

After breakfast, we drive down to Borneo Highland Resort which is one of the most exciting and unique eco-friendly resort development in the region. It is just within an hour's drive (60km) from Kuching City, the capital of Sarawak – The Land of Hornbills. Borneo Highland Resort nestles majestically amongst the 1.5 million years old virgin rainforest, the 2nd oldest and 2nd largest rainforest in the world. Our highland tour includes visiting to the Flower Garden, Vertical Garden, Rose Garden, Kalimantan Border View, Chinese Tea House, Swan Lake & Rabbit Park. Lunch will be served at Annah Rais Café. After lunch, it's free at leisure before transfer back to city hotel.

### Day 3 Departure from Kuching (B/L)

After breakfast, we check-out from hotel and drive down to the SARAWAK CULTURAL VILLAGE. A unique award-winning living museum is a "must see" attraction if you would like to experience Sarawak's cultural in half a day. The Sarawak Cultural Village is situated on a 17-acre site at the foothill of the legendary Mount Santubong, fronting the South China Sea. The village offers a golden opportunity to see and to explore the diversity of multi-racial cultural, lifestyle, history, tradition and architecture. There are seven fascinating houses representing every major ethnic group in Sarawak such as the Bidayuh House (known as Land Dayak), the Iban House (known as Sea Dayak), the Orang Ulu Longhouse, the Penan Jungle Settlement, the Melanau Tall House, the Malay Town House and the Chinese Farm House. All the houses are staffed with members in their own unique traditional costume and our experience guide will describe and interpret their lifestyle as well as their traditional cultures. Later, a 45-minute extraordinary cultural show will be held in the in-house theatre. The magnificent yet colorful costumes will make your visit to the Sarawak Cultural Village a memorable one. Lunch is served at local restaurant. Our tour ends with a transfer to Kuching International Airport for your departure flight.
