Day 1 Kuching City & Shopping Tour

Upon arrival at Kuching International Airport, our friendly representative will meet and accompany you to KUCHING CITY & SHOPPING TOUR. Kuching's city centre is well-preserved with its historical buildings and this is clearly reflected when you move around the city. Kuching has been divided into North and South led by the 2 capable mayors. The 'Astana', General Post Office, City Tower, The Sarawak Museum are among the fine examples of colonial-style architectures. A visit to the prominent landmarks such as the famous Kuching Waterfront, Tua Pek Kong Temple, Main Bazaar, Carpenter Street and the Chinese Museum will sure bring your memories alive. The world's first Cat Museum, a must visit attraction offers variety of cat souvenirs, photos and exhibits. It will definitely makes you love more about Kuching. Kuching also offers a wide range of local souvenirs such as pepper sweets, pepper biscuits, pepper root and pepper perfume, bird-nests, Sarawak potteries, arts and crafts which can be found in Kuching. After tour, transfer to city hotel of your choice for check-in.

Day 2 Semenggoh Orang Utan-Crocodile Farm-Shopping Tour- Sarawak River Cruise (B/L)



After breakfast, we are greeted by our tour guide proceed to **SEMENGGOH ORANG UTAN**. The journey to the Semenggoh Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre takes approximately 30 minutes drive from the Kuching city center. Here we take a short hike through the dipterocarp forest. Young orang utans are trained to survive in the wild. These orang utans are either orphaned or rescued from captivity. When they have sufficient skills to survive in the wild, the orang utans are released into the wild forest. During the feeding time, visitors can watch their skillful movement and to observe their behavior and characteristics. Watching these charming and entertaining orang utans during feeding time is a sheer delight. Most importantly, spot their delicate nests and our experience tour guide will elaborates more of this special primate called "Man of the forest". Other animals found in the sanctuary are the gibbons and honey bears. Our second part of the journey continues to **CROCODILE BREEDING FARM CUM MINI ZOO**. It is situated at 18½-mile (29km) Kuching/Serian highway, a 20-minute leisure drive from Kuching. It is one of the largest and the only crocodile breeding farm in the country. Set amidst the charming backdrop of tall tropical trees, lush vegetation and local fruits trees lies this unique farm with over a thousand crocodiles bred in captivity. The farm provides a perfect sanctuary for the reptiles, saving the species from extinction. There are huge and deep concrete ponds and natural breeding grounds for the crocodiles to mate and multiply. Visitors are able to gaze at the snapping jaws, cold menacing eyes, sharp pointed teeth and powerful lashing tails of the crocs within short distance yet safe because of the metal fences. Apart from crocodiles there are also numerous rare species of birds and animals found only in the Borneo Island. Visitors can have enchanting experience of walking freely among the monkeys, leopard-cats, sunbears, bearcats, pheasants, civets, barking deers, sambar deers, turtles, fruit bat, monitor lizards, pythons and even hornbills.

After lunch at local restaurant, we are back to the city for a **SHOPPING TOUR**. Kuching is a shopping paradise if you are looking for the Borneo arts and crafts. A stop at Main Bazaar enables the visitors to shop for the famous Sarawak wood carving, mat, pua kumbu etc. Next, we visit a bird nest processing factory where a video presentation is shown in a very spacious show room. Apart from the exotic bird nest delicacies, other souvenirs such as the pepper products (pepper sweets, pepper biscuits, pepper root and pepper perfume), key chains and T-shirts can also be found in the factory with the most reasonable price. Another well-known souvenir is the pottery and it is definitely unique. You can watch or even get your hand on to do your own pottery in the factory.

After the shopping tour, we proceed to our **SARAWAK RIVER CRUISE**. A great way to experience the lifestyle of Kuching is through the Sarawak River Cruise. The cruise departs from the famous Kuching waterfront and along the way, visitors can

Day 03 Sarawak Cultural Village

After breakfast at the hotel, we check out and begin our day in **SARAWAK CULTURAL VILLAGE**. A unique award-winning living museum is a "must see" attraction if you would like to experience Sarawak's cultural in half a day. The Sarawak Cultural Village is situated on a 17-acre site at the foothill of the legendary Mount Santubong, fronting the South China Sea. The village offers a golden opportunity to see and to explore the diversity of multi-racial cultural, lifestyle,



history, tradition and architecture. There are seven fascinating houses representing every major ethnic group in Sarawak such as the Bidayuh House (known as Land Dayak), Iban House (known as Sea Dayak), Orang Ulu Longhouse, Penan Jungle Settlement, Melanau Tall House, Malay Town House and Chinese Farm House. All these houses are staffed with members dressed in their own traditional costumes and our experience guide will describe and interpret their lifestyle as well as their traditional cultures. A 45-minute extraordinary cultural show will be held in the theatre. The magnificent yet colourful costumes will make your visit to the Sarawak Cultural Village a memorable one. Lunch is served at local restaurant. After that our tour ends for the day with a transfer to the resort of your choice for check-in & overnight.
